Cost

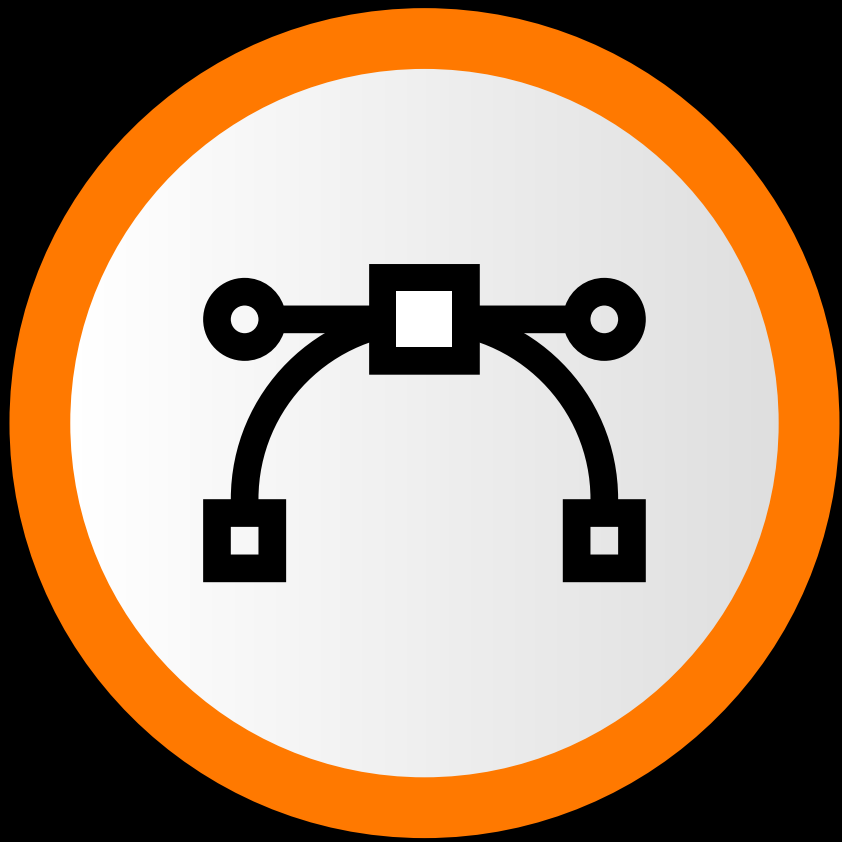

Interoperability

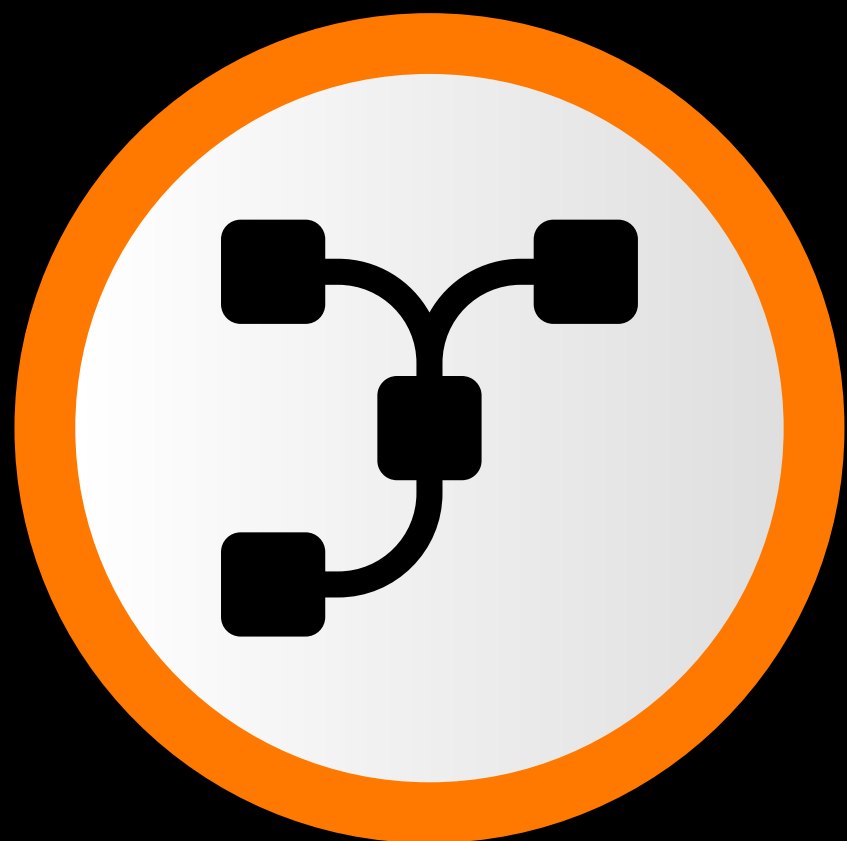
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Open source LMSs are often designed to be **interoperable with other systems and software**, making it easier to integrate them into an organization's existing technology stack.
